

Weiss Grove Campers' Association Regulations

Approved at Annual Meeting - July 2014

1. Quiet shall be observed after 11 p.m., Sunday-Thursday evenings out of consideration for the many summer residents who commute to work. Please refrain from loud sounds or noisy conversations.
2. No lights are to be on, or games played on the Recreation Field after 10 p.m., from Sunday-Thursday or after 12 p.m., Friday-Saturday, out of consideration for campers in nearby camps.
3. As the roads are narrow and visibility is limited, vehicles may not travel above the posted speed limits any time when entering or leaving the Grove in order to protect life and property and to preserve the roads. The limits are 20 mph from the entrance of the Grove to the top of the hill on Weiss Grove Road and 10 mph on the remainder of the Grove roads. The speed limit on roads in the recreation field area is 5 mph.
4. Everyone is responsible for maintaining a safe and positive environment in the Grove. Any serious trouble should be reported to the Saratoga County Sheriff's Department or State Police.
5. Services presented by the Association are provided for the traditional campers' season.
6. Arrangements will be made, if possible, to place a dumpster in the Recreation Field during the summer months for the convenience of members in disposing of their bagged household garbage. Construction debris should never be placed in the Grove dumpster. The availability of the dumpster will be determined each year and the dates for use will be posted. Only waste generated at the Grove may be placed in the dumpster by members in good standing.* Members shall make their own arrangements for recycling.
7. Only leaves may be disposed of in the open trench behind the Field House. All leaves must be emptied from plastic bags. Only leaves from properties in the Grove may be deposited in the trench. A \$50 fine for improper dumping shall be imposed for anyone found not obeying this regulation.
8. In the spring each year a chain or locked gate will close the entrance to the Recreation Field and leaf dump because of the wet conditions of the field and road at that time of year. At times when the entrance is closed the President or other custodian of the key to the gate, designated by the President, must be contacted if access is needed.
9. All Association assessments are due and payable to the treasurer within 30 days following the annual meeting of the Association, usually held in July. Thereafter an additional fee will be charged. This enables our Association to meet its obligations and undertake projects for the benefit of our Association.
10. The Field House and grounds may be used by members in good standing only, through approval of the Association President. The rental and deposit amounts for use of the facilities shall be set annually by the Association Board of Directors. After the building and grounds are left in satisfactory condition, the deposit will be returned. The member must be present at all times

during this use of facilities and is responsible for cleanup for all areas used. Quiet time, as set forth in Sections 1 and 2 shall be observed with regard to this rental.

11. Outside repairs or additions to property of private owners or the Association require a building permit because of the building codes of the Town of Galway. Contact the Zoning Administrator or Town Clerk at the Town Hall, Route 147, Galway.
12. Rules regarding the use of the Lake are set and communicated by Galway Lake Campers' Association and are expected to be followed by members of this Association.
13. Our Association maintains three access paths to the lakefront and two access locations to the Recreation Field. Out of respect to the property of private owners, only these accesses should be used.
14. All docks on the lakefront are privately owned and their use is controlled by the individual owners.
15. Any non-paying member, for the preceding year, shall be barred from holding any office and use of any Weiss Grove facilities and privileges until that individual becomes a member in good standing. *

* Members in good standing are those members who have paid their annual assessment by the due date [August 31 as provided in the Bylaws], and are not in arrears from past years' assessments.
